Impact Report 2024

At the start of 2024, Eyewitness Palestine remained deeply engaged in responding to the ongoing genocide in Gaza. In March, our dedicated staff successfully led a two-week medical mission to Gaza, delivering critical support and solidarity on the ground. After nearly two years of suspension, we resumed our in-person delegations to Palestine with the Black in the Holyland BIPOC delegation in December—marking a significant milestone in our commitment to transformative educational delegations to Palestine. Throughout the year, we continued to expand our reach through dynamic educational programming, including webinars and virtual delegations, while also deepening our mutual aid initiatives in solidarity with Palestinian communities on the ground.

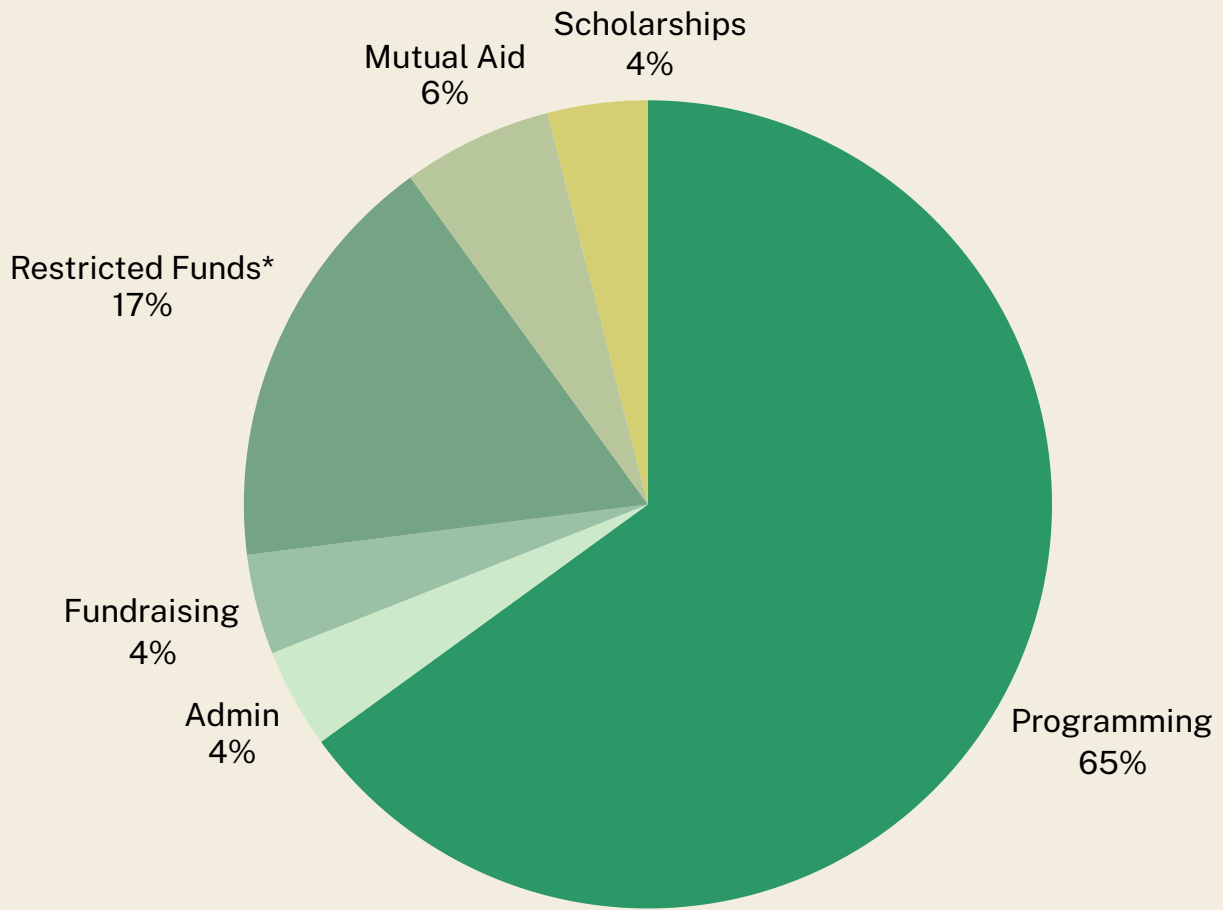
IMPACT SNAPSHOT

Medical Mission to Gaza	March 2024	Eyewitness Palestine staff, in partnership with Glia, led a 2 week successful medical mission of 10 doctors to Gaza
Black in the Holyland	December 2024	BIPOC delegation included visits with the Afro Palestinian society, the Bedouin community in Rahat, and more.

GAZA INITIATIVE

- In 2024, we were able to donate a little over \$20,000 through various organizations, including food, hygiene products, and medical supplies, as well as books and toys for children.



VIRTUAL PROGRAMMING

WEBINARS & MUTUAL AID PROGRAMS

- Built strong relationships with organizations on the ground.
- Donated to 5 organizations doing direct work in Palestine.
- Raised over \$48,000 for partner organizations on the ground, including:
 - Allocated \$2,500 to support the work of Autism Superhero, which enabled the delivery of high-quality training to families of children with ASD in the West Bank, as well as \$6,000 to the Phoenix Writing School in Gaza through Playgrounds for Palestine.
 - Secured a little over \$22,000 for Women's center for Legal Aid and Counseling (WCLAC) in Palestine.

VIRTUAL DELEGATIONS

- Filmed and hosted 12 virtual delegations to cities around Palestine.
- Through our monthly webinars and virtual delegations to different cities across Palestine, we elevated critical Palestinian voices and provide platforms for important social and political conversations.

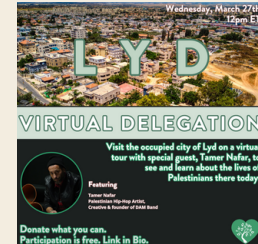
